General Festival Information

We look forward to welcoming you to Dartmouth's second Festival of Healing Arts. Please find below some general information which aims to make your experience with us as pleasurable as possible.

FESTIVAL LOCATIONS

A venue map is attached. The Flavel, Guildhall and The Royal Castle Hotel are all within a five minute walk of each other.

PARKING

There is free unlimited parking along the main embankment and many of the side roads after 1st October. See attached venue map **but** please check the street signs for parking restriction details.

The town's main car park (pay and display) is directly opposite The Flavel.

THE FLAVEL OPENING TIMES

Thursday 4th December

Opening reception & 'Meet the Fockers' film. Reception from 7 pm and the film starts at 8 pm.

Friday 5th December

Stalls and therapists from 2 pm until 7pm. On stage events until 11pm (please note if you wish to attend Jewls' Ecstatic Tantra Dance, the doors close at 9.15 pm).

Saturday 6th December

Stalls and therapists from 10 am to 6pm. On stage performance finishes at 6.30pm.

Sunday 7th December

Stalls and therapists from 10 am to 5pm.

On stage performance finishes at approximately 4.30 pm.

Please note we are expecting quite a few visitors for the Goma performance on Sunday, so arrive early to guarantee entry (starts at 2pm in the Flavel hall). Even though you have an entry ticket and the hall is full, you won't be admitted until space becomes available.
